

BOARDING

All boarding pupils will be in shared or individual rooms, depending on their year group - with the following items provided by the School:

- Standard Japanese-sized single bed and mattress
- Fitted sheets
- Duvet and cover
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Desk with lockable drawer
- Desk lamp
- Office chair
- Small number of coathangers
- Hairdryer

To make rooms feel more cosy, boarders are welcome but not required to bring any items that help personalise their space including:

- Own bedding (instead of RSJ supplied bedding)
- Stuffed animals
- Photographs

The School laundry service operates daily within the Houses, and will ensure that bedding, uniforms and home clothes are all washed and dried for the boarding pupils.

It is essential that personal items are all clearly named to reduce the risk of them going missing. The School shirts are designed to be non-iron, however, an iron and ironing board will be provided for use in the House laundry rooms if needed.
